2. Website Terms of Use

§1. General Provisions This document sets out the rules for using the website of Judyta Toruń — certified classical homeopath, founder and creator of classical homeopathy standards, available at www.judytatorun.pl (hereinafter: the "Website"). The Website is informational, presentational and contact-oriented in nature. Using the Website constitutes acceptance of these terms.

§2. Nature of the Website The Website serves to present the administrator's professional activity, including her experience as a certified classical homeopath, ongoing projects (Centrum Homeoterapii) and initiatives (Standards of Classical Homeopathy). The Website also enables contact via a contact form.

The content published on the Website is exclusively informational and presentational in nature. The Website is not intended for concluding online contracts, maintaining user accounts or online sales, unless explicitly stated otherwise.

The content published on the Website does not constitute medical, health, therapeutic or any other individual professional advice. The materials are general in nature and cannot replace an individual consultation with a qualified specialist.

§3. Rules of Use The user agrees to use the Website in a manner consistent with applicable law, good practices and the purpose of the Website.

In particular, the following are prohibited: providing unlawful content, taking actions that may disrupt the functioning of the Website, attempting to gain unauthorised access to the Website or its resources, using content published on the Website in a manner contrary to its purpose, context or applicable law.

§4. Contact Form and Contact The user may contact the administrator via the contact form available on the Website or directly by e-mail. Sending a message does not constitute the conclusion of any contract or an obligation to conclude one. The administrator may respond to a message if its content allows for it and if the contact is justified.

§5. Copyright The content published on the Website, in particular texts, descriptions, documents, content layout, graphics and materials, is subject to legal protection, including copyright protection. Copying, distributing, modifying, adapting or further using such content without the administrator's consent is prohibited, except as permitted by applicable law.

3. Privacy Policy

§2. Scope of Data Through the Website, data voluntarily provided by the user may be processed, in particular: full name, e-mail address, the content of the message sent via the contact form, and any other data the user voluntarily provides in their message.

§3. Purposes of Processing Personal data may be processed for the following purposes: handling messages sent via the contact form or by e-mail, conducting correspondence, responding to questions or messages, protection against abuse and ensuring the security of the Website, and the possible establishment, pursuit or defence of claims.

§4. Legal Bases for Processing Personal data are processed on the basis of: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR — the legitimate interest of the administrator, consisting in conducting correspondence, handling contact, protecting the Website and defending against claims; Article 6(1)(c) GDPR — where processing is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation; Article 6(1)(a) GDPR — where the user has given consent, to the extent covered by that consent.

§5. Voluntary Nature of Data Provision Providing data is voluntary, but may be necessary to send a message and receive a response.

§6. Recipients of Data Data may be transferred to entities providing technical support for the operation of the Website, e-mail, hosting or the contact form — solely to the extent necessary for the operation of the Website and handling of contact.

§7. Data Retention Period Data will be stored for the period necessary to handle the correspondence, and then for the time required for archiving or defence against claims — no longer than necessary.

§8. Rights of the Data Subject The data subject has the right to: access their data, rectify their data, erase their data, restrict processing, object to processing, withdraw consent at any time (where data are processed on the basis of consent), and lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO).

§9. Cookies The Website uses cookies necessary for its proper functioning (e.g. remembering the acceptance of the cookie banner). If analytical or marketing cookies are also used on the Website, they are activated only after obtaining the user's consent.

§10. Amendments to the Privacy Policy The administrator may update this privacy policy, in particular in the event of legal, organisational or technical changes.
